**Recruitment Rules for the Non – Teaching posts in
School of Planning and Architecture (SPAs).**

1. **Short title and commencement:** These rules may be called the SPAs Non-Teaching Recruitment Rules, 2025 (RRs). These shall come into force from the date of their adoption by the Board of Governors of the concerned Institute and shall apply prospectively. The officer/staff holding the respective post on regular basis, shall be deemed to have been appointed on the said post.
2. **Definitions:** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires;
 - (i) “Act” means School of Planning and Architecture (SPA) Act, 2014.
 - (ii) “Statutes” means the First Statutes of the SPAs and the Statutes subsequently framed by the respective SPA or framed by the Ministry of Education.
 - (iii) “Service Rules” means Service Rules as prescribed under SPA Act and Statutes.
 - (iv) “Council” means the School of Planning and Architecture (SPA) Council as constituted under Section 33 of the School of Planning and Architecture (SPA) Act, 2014
3. **Method of Recruitment and other matters:** The method of recruitment, financial upgradation and other matter relating to the post of non-teaching shall be specified in the SPAs Non-Teaching Recruitment Rules 2025 (attached). Any amendment to these RRs shall be done only by the SPA Council as per Section 35(2)(d) of the Act. However, where it is not expedient to convene a meeting of the Council, the Member Secretary may, with the approval of the Chairperson of the Council, circulate the proposed amendment(s) in RRs, as are considered necessary, among the Members so as to obtain their comments to enable the Chairperson of the Council to take decision thereon and such matter shall be reported to the Council in its next meeting.
4. **Saving:** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations of the age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard. These rules shall also not affect the recruitments already made; but any appointment or promotion made subsequent to the approval / adoption of these Recruitment Rules will be governed by these RRs.
5. **One time measures / relaxations:** Those employees, who are working on ad-hoc /temporary / contractual / outsource basis, in SPAs, may be given one-time age relaxation to participate in the first regular recruitment process after these RRs come into force, for the post for which they fulfil all other conditions mentioned in the RRs. The quantum of age relaxation may be decided by the Board of Governors of the respective SPA. The relaxation in upper age limit shall be clearly brought out in advertisement for the relevant post. This one-time age relaxation shall have no validity and shall stand exhausted for all posts (whether or not advertised for the first recruitment

process after the RRs come into force) after the first recruitment process.

6. **General Guidelines:** (i) For officers/staff cadres, wherever the mode of recruitment is through promotion as well as direct recruitment and number of position are less than 04, minimum number of positions to be earmarked for promotion will be 01 In other words, the posts should be filled as follows:

If no. of sanctioned posts are	Then distribution of posts would be as
1	1: Promotion
2	1: Promotion 1: Direct Recruitment

(ii) Incumbent who are working on the posts which are presently having higher pay scales may be allowed to continue on the same pay scale, so that they may not be put in a disadvantageous position.

(iii) No interviews may be conducted in junior level posts upto Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) irrespective of mode of appointment i.e promotion, deputation, direct recruitment etc. (As per DoPT guidelines issued vide O.M. No. 39020/02/2016-Estt.(B) dated 13.04.2017). Merit for direct recruitment/selection of these junior level posts shall be drawn based on written test.

(iv) Any prescribed skill test or physical test shall be of a qualifying nature only. No marks shall be awarded for such tests and they shall not be included to determine merit. The number of candidates called for appearing in the qualifying skill test/physical test shall be the same as the number of available positions to be filled who shall be called in the order of merit drawn based on written test. If any post remains vacant due to a candidate not qualifying the skill test/physical test or for any other reason, the candidate next in merit will be called for the qualifying test.

(v) For every written examination or skill/physical test, the Institute must appoint an external observer with expertise in recruitment process. The observer shall be appointed only with prior approval of the Board of Governors.

(vi) Where interview is part of the recruitment/selection process, the number of candidates to be called for interview with respect to the number of posts advertised shall be in the ratio of 5:1.

7. **Other conditions of service:** The other conditions of service of the non-teaching officials for which no specific provisions have been made in these rules shall be regulated in accordance with such rules as are, from time to time, applicable as per the First Statutes of the SPAs and the subsequent amendments. For matters not covered by the Statutes, the corresponding Central Government Rules shall be applicable.

8. These rules are bare minimum and the Board of Governors can, however, fix benchmarks higher than the prescribed with the prior approval of the Council of SPAs.
